After leaving Mbita, we went on a 2-day safari in the Maasai Mara.....WOW! We saw nearly every animal imaginable in that vast beautiful area. Stayed in a tent camp similar to a wall tent during hunting camp in MT, except each tent had its own toilet, shower and sink, and there was electricity in the evenings when they had the generator on.

Yesterday we arrived in Nairobi....went to a nice shopping mall for lunch, where Steve and Judy Cochrane met us and spent several hours with us. During that time, Steve called Bob Coughlin and a couple of us were able to talk with him back in Montana.

Nine people from our group flew out last night, and four more early this morning. Now it is just the eight of us from Peace Lutheran remaining. We stayed at the ACK Guesthouse here in Nairobi last night and we are just finishing breakfast. In an hour, we will be picked up and brought to the Girls Rescue Center.....we will stay there tonight and they will get us to the airport late tomorrow evening (March 5) to begin the long flights home. We have several hours layover in Amsterdam so may take the train into the city to look around.
