"If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" 2 Corinthians 5:17

There was an article not long ago in *Leadership* magazine about a little boy named Phillip. Phillip was born with Down's syndrome, and he attended a third-grade Sunday school class with several eight-year-old boys and girls. Typical of that age, the kids did not readily accept Phillip with his differences. But because of a creative teacher, they began to care about Phillip and accept him as part of the group, though not fully. The Sunday after Easter the teacher brought Leggs pantyhose containers, the kind that looked like large eggs. Each receiving one, the kids were told to go outside on that lovely spring day, find some symbol of new life, and put it in the egg-like containers.

After running around the church property in wild confusion, the students returned to the classroom and placed the containers on the table. Surrounded by the children the teacher began to open them one by one. After each one, whether they saw a flower, butterfly, or leaf, the class would ooh and aah. Then one was opened, but it had nothing inside. The kids yelled, "That's stupid. That's not fair. Somebody didn't do their assignment."

Phillip spoke up, "That's mine." "Phillip, you don't ever do things right!" the kids said. "There's nothing there." "I did so do it!" Phillip said. "I did do it. It's empty because Jesus' tomb was empty!" Silence followed. From then on Phillip became a fully accepted member of the class.

Phillip died not long afterward from an infection most healthy kids would have shrugged off. At the funeral at his church this class of eight-year-olds marched up to the altar and each one of them placed on the altar an empty Leggs pantyhose container.

As we think about Phillip and his classmates it seems to me that we should ask ourselves, "Is there anyone in my life that I am not accepting as Christ would have me do because they are so different from me?" We would do will to remember that the ground under the cross of Christ is level and that the resurrection power of Easter morning is meant for everyone. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

Sisters and brothers in Christ, God has given us the empty tomb as a sign of new life and the new creation that all people can have in Christ Jesus. By the cross and the resurrection believers are dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed!!

### What a grand Easter Celebration!



Several members of PLC gathered for a sunrise worship of the Risen Lord. Folks crowded into the Fellowship Hall as the youth served hot breakfast casseroles, fresh fruit, and wonderful baked goods that members of the congregation prepared. Kids scrambled to find Easter Eggs that were planted around the church building as the sanctuary began to fill up for the second worship service. A full sanctuary and the overflow group in the Fellowship Hall heard the news that 'King Jesus is arisen on this glorious Easter Day!'

Our Easter Celebration was the culmination of a long Lenten Journey of reflection, repentance and appreciation of the price that Jesus paid for our salvation. And, celebrate we should!

But, now that the Easter Season is over... what next? After a climactic finish like the one Easter provides, it feels like time to scale back a bit, take our foot off the gas pedal, and take some time for needed rest and relaxation after the busyness of the extended season. I'll be the first to admit that a little R&R is what my body needs!

That, however, is not what Jesus had in mind for his followers after that first Easter. The evening after the morning of the resurrection, Jesus met up with his disciples who were behind locked doors for fear of the Jews. His greeting of "shalom" was followed by the disciples exploring the wounds of Jesus to verify he was really their Lord and Master. Understandably, that led to a time of great rejoicing! They knew that Jesus is alive!

But, it wasn't time to rest on their laurels. They didn't take it easy now that their Savior finished what he came to do. Jesus wouldn't let them do that. There was more to do! Jesus charged his followers with the instructions: "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." (Jn. 20:21)

Jesus saw that there was more work to be done. True, the saving work of Jesus was finished as he died and rose again. But, the world now needs to know about it. People must *hear* the news and *believe* in order to benefit from the good news! And, Jesus leaves that job to his followers.

He doesn't just let us know what needs to be done, but how. "As the Father sent me..." We are sent in a way similar to the way Jesus was sent. He lived among those who needed to hear the message of God's love and reconciliation. He was sent not to be served, but to serve and to give. He came to do the works of God to display the character of God for all to see and know. Jesus was sent as the incarnation of God. That is how Jesus sends us. As the Father sent him.

We just have to look around us to find that we still have work to be done. Let us do it together!




