With the start of September, our calendars begin to fill up

with the beginning of the school year. Activities at school, community

programs and seasonal activities are all a part of our Fall Schedules. The same is happening at Peace Lutheran Church!

Our "Sunday School Advisory Team" has met to plan for our 2018-19 Christian Education programs for the young people in our congregation. We have struggled in the past finding committed volunteers and regular student attendance. So, we are trying something new in hopes that we can address some of these issues.

Due to the number of "start-ups" in the September calendar, we are planning to begin our Sunday School program <u>October 7</u>. We will run our first six-week unit through <u>November 11</u>. We begin again with a unit to prepare our kids for Christmas that will run from <u>December 2</u> ending with Kid's and Youth Choirs at Sunday Worship on <u>December 23</u>.

Sunday School will resume on <u>January 20</u>. We will again run a six-week unit through <u>February</u> <u>24</u>. Our final unit beginning on <u>March 24</u> through <u>April 14</u> will focus on the events leading up to and including Easter. That will conclude our season or Sunday School.

The materials for each of these units will be from Sola Publishing a source for Lutheran Educational materials that we have been using the past few years. Attention this year will be on stories from the Acts of the new church and the Letters written to new believers.

After looking at the break-down in ages of the youth in our congregation, we have decided to try the following groups: Pre-K-Kindergarten; 1-2 Grades; 3-5 Grades; 6-12 Grades.


