As we wrap up September, it is evident that we have transitioned into a new season! The days are shorter and cooler, our windshield's need scraping each morning, our gardens are done for the year. Autumn is upon us. Let's hope we don't have to take out the snow shovels for a while!



At Peace Lutheran we have also undergone a transition of sorts. With the summer-season, programs at the church are paired back and we enjoy a slower pace. But that changes in the Fall. We have several opportunities that are being planned of which I hope you will consider being a part.

Providing **Christian Education** opportunities is a priority for us as a "People of Faith". Please consider the following and how they might connect with something you might be interested in:

- Sunday School begins October 7 and continues most Sundays during the school year.
 Starting around 10:30 each Sunday, Pre-Kindergarten through fifth graders gather in the sanctuary for singing and then disperse into groups for classroom education. 'PLC Youth', grades 6-12 will gather in the basement Youth Room and adults in the Fellowship Hall for various instruction.
- Confirmation instruction begins September 30 at 6-7pm, for youth in grades 8, 9 and 10. We will be looking at what makes us "Lutheran" and "Christian".
- Afternoon Bible Discussion begins October 2 and will meet Tuesdays at 1:30-3:00 in the Fellowship Hall. We will be talking about various characters from the Old Testament.
- Family Bible Study begins October 16 for six weeks. Dianne and I will host the group at our home from 6-7 pm. Childcare is provided!
- Thursday Book Club begins October 4 and meets at 7 pm in the Youth Room or Fellowship Hall, depending on availability.

Service opportunities are also an important part of our calling. Among the ministries you can be a part of are: Food Bank Distribution, the Clothes Closet, Fork and Spoon, Family Promise, ROC Wheels, Habitat for Humanity, Repiecers, Altar Guild, Blood Drives, Choir, Worship Teams, and Congregational Committees.

You see, there is a lot of areas to invest yourself in ways that will help stretch and grow your faith as well as strengthen your connection to the Family of God at PLC. I hope you will choose something that will help you in your journey of faith and life with God.

Oh, we also have Worship Services every Sunday morning at 9:00!
