Dear Peace Lutheran Family,

It was wonderful to worship the Lord with you during Lent and Easter. What an awesome journey! As I look back on it, there were many highlights that encouraged me spiritually. One of them was getting the opportunity to sing in the choir. Not that I am an experienced choir singer, but I thoroughly enjoyed it because it allowed me to reflect on the Scriptures differently. When I was singing, I felt like I was "in the stories" of Christ's sacrificial love and resurrection.

Also, to many of you who volunteered (e.g. playing and singing music, preparing food, reading Scripture, decorating the sanctuary and fellowship hall, doing yard work around the church property, etc.) thank you so much! You helped make Lent and Easter an amazing experience!

After Easter, perhaps you are wondering, "Where do we go from here?" Obviously, there is a lot of anticipation and excitement for Easter Sunday, and for good reason! Jesus defeated the grave! However, the "celebration" of Christ's resurrection doesn't stop on Easter. Rather, for the next several weeks, we will spend time learning about how Jesus' victory over death still brings us amazing joy and hope today. One of my favorite stories during the Easter Season is when Jesus shared his amazing joy and hope with Thomas. [According to Beloved John's gospel, in chapter 20, Thomas wasn't with the others when the Lord appeared to them the first time.] When Thomas regathered with the disciples, they told him that the resurrected Jesus came to them. Thomas thought they were insane! He needed proof: "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe (John 20:25)."

Why did Thomas doubt them? Why was he afraid? A little background might be helpful. After Jesus' resurrection, before he appeared to his disciples, they were hiding behind locked doors out of fear of the Jewish religious authorities. Also, the disciples didn't believe the extraordinary report from Mary Magdalene and the other women who witnessed and reported Jesus' resurrection first. So, from Thomas' point-of-view, without seeing Jesus, with their lack of faith in the women's testimony, and knowing the intense fear that gripped them, their report of Jesus appearing to them inside a locked house sounded like gibberish. If we were in Thomas' situation, we would have responded the same way. How did Jesus react to their doubts and fears?

He went to them again in that locked house: "Peace be with you (John 20:26)." Then, he approached Thomas—and showing his scarred hands and side—Jesus said to him, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe (John 20:27)." Do you see what happened? Jesus—in His glorified and resurrected body—invited Thomas to not only see his scars but to touch them, alleviating the "scars" of doubt and fear that were crippling him, and instead, Thomas' heart was renewed with amazing joy and hope: "My Lord and my God (John 20:28)." In the same way, Jesus—the Resurrection and the Life—invites us to worship him in his house, learn from His word, and participate in receiving the bread and the wine at his table where we "touch" and "taste" His grace and forgiveness, so that we—in agreement with Thomas—can say with renewed joy and hope: "My Lord and my God."




