Dear Family of Peace Lutheran Church,

Summertime greetings to you all. As we enter the final month of summer, we are not yet half-way through the Season of Pentecost. Starting in early June, we celebrate God's gift of the Holy Spirit descending on the believers in the Risen Savior and we begin the long journey that draws attention to our growth as His Disciples.

As we make our way through the Gospel of Luke, we hear Jesus' teachings, witness his miracles and pick up on the reactions of his first followers. We also have been hearing the words of Paul to the Galatians and Colossians as he encourages the church, instructs them and gives them hope.

While words of instruction can feel burdensome, even punitive, we are reminded of God's love for all of us and his ever-present care through the prayers in the Book of Psalms which lifts our eyes to appreciate these things.

Summer is supposed to be more relaxed than the rest of the year, yet it quickly becomes just as hectic, though perhaps in a different way. Routines are replaced by other activities that keep us busy. Well aware of the brevity of our 'Montana Summer', we pack in as much as we can to get the most out of it! Often our plans to relax and take a little breather from the pace of the other seasons get pre-empted by activities that keep our schedules bursting.

That is when we need to think about the prayer in Psalm 100. It calls us away from being focused on our own agendas, our own worries and our own concerns, to look to the Lord. To worship Him. To give him thanks and praise – with gladness!!

The psalmist reminds us of the Lord's sovereignty over us along with his gentle and generous care.

I find that I need to be reminded of this. When my focus is on *me* and *my* plans, I somehow forget (or, just take for granted) God's qualities of goodness, love and faithfulness. I easily lose sight of his constant care and generous mercy. I don't take the time to "enter his gates", much less with thanksgiving!

Pentecost helps us through a long season of walking with the Lord, as his disciples who learn from him, to feel his love and urges us to be thankful.

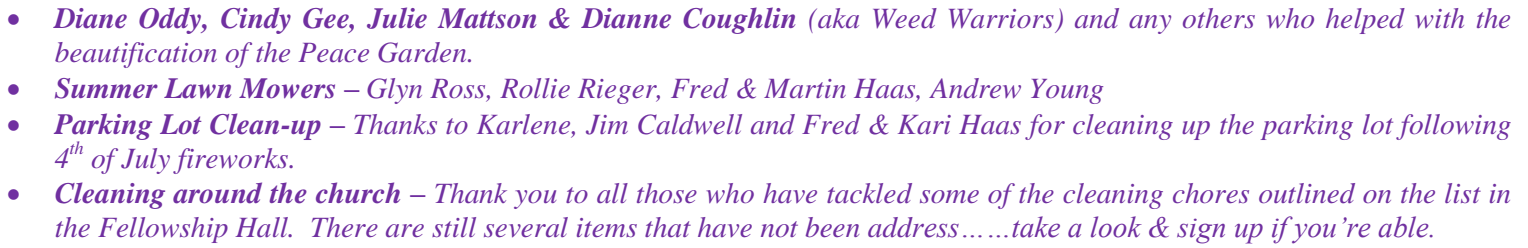
