Siding Support: 60-Day \$45K Challenge!

Calling all Peace Lutheran members! As discussed at the annual meeting held Sunday, January 26, 2020, we are at a critical time to replace the siding on the church building this summer.

The siding replacement is necessary to both fix the exterior and prevent further damage to the interior of the building, which would require even higher replacement costs.

As a congregation, we need your involvement to make this a reality, and are asking your help to raise \$45,000 in the next 60 days so we can move forward with the plan.

Numerous quotes have been reviewed and a motion was passed at the Annual Meeting that a maximum of \$65,000 will be budgeted to this effort; \$20,000 will be contributed from the current PLC Building Fund, leaving a total of \$45,000 to be raised.

Please prayerfully consider your involvement and donate to make this project a reality in the next 60 days. All donations will be reported on your giving statement. **Deadline for donation commitments is March 29, 2020.**


