We have only just celebrated the birth of God's Savior, Jesus. It seems like a few days ago! I am still humming carols and have yet to clean my boots after our Christmas Eve worship in the barn. But the calendar has turned to 2020 and we have entered a new year! 2019 ended on a high note at PLC with the Seasons of Advent and Christmas. Our worship was enhanced by the many talented members of our Church Family. We are blessed with musicians, voices and those who serve to lift our hearts in worship.

As we enter the New Year, we come into a new season of the church year – Epiphany, which takes us through until Ash Wednesday. During Christmas we joyfully celebrated the coming of the "great light" in the birth of Jesus, God's Only Son. Now, the Feast of the Epiphany brings this theme to culmination – the light of Christ made manifest to the whole world as embodied by the Magi from the East.

The common theme is manifestation, we reacquaint ourselves with the expressions of the light that has shown in the darkness. Epiphany is a season of enlightenment. It starts with the Magi who came from the East to bring gifts and to worship the newborn King of the Jews. For the next several weeks we will be looking at Scriptures that reveal who is this King and what he came to do.

Jesus invites the curious to "*Come and see*" as he brings healing to the sick and in need... as he confronts opposition to his behavior and his teachings... as he does the miraculous to ease the suffering of others, validating who he really is! Epiphany is a season for seeing more of Christ's glory by focusing on his life and mission. Jesus will also say to his followers, "*Go and tell*."


