Dear Family at Peace Lutheran,

There has been a lot to complain about lately. The continued spread of COVID 19 is getting closer and closer to each of us and affects our every-day of life. The divisions created by this month's elections and increasing distrust in our local and nation's leaders. The racial unrest in our country. The wild fires still raging in the west and our sudden change to extreme winter weather... need I go on?

It is easy for us to take on a sour attitude. If our focus is on what has been going wrong, that is all we can see. I am not denying the negative, the sad, or the evil that confronts us, I just want to warn us against becoming consumed by it. But *celebrate*?

No doubt, you have fallen victim to that consumption at one time or another. When everything we look at is wrong or has room to be made better, we take on a 'glass is half-full' attitude or we feel like 'if we didn't have bad luck, we would have no luck at all!' In the midst of it all, Paul urges us to celebrate. He doesn't tell us to wait until things get better before we celebrate, Paul's command is to do so now! In the midst of trouble. Paul's exhortations continue:

Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns.

Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down.

It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life. (Phil. 4:6-7)

God sees a different picture than we are sometimes able. It is not that God ignores or doesn't care about the evil and hard things we must endure. But He sees the difference between what is eternal and what is simply passing. God is confident in his control and his love for us is undeniable.

So, we need not fret or worry. But we are told to pray. We pray because God is able to make the bad come out good and to bring wholeness out of that which has been shattered. Let us be people who pray instead of those who complain. Trusting in God and celebrating his goodness! Letting Christ displace our worry.


