Dear Peace Lutheran Family,

Thinking of the many blessings that we have in Christ, I'm reminded of the beautiful hymn, "How Great Thou Art." Specifically, in verses 3-4, "And when I think that God, His Son not sparing, send Him to die, I scarce can take it in—That on the cross, my burden gladly bearing, He bled and died to take away my sin... When Christ shall come with shout of acclamation and take me home, what joy shall fill my heart! Then I shall bow in humble adoration and there proclaim, My God, how great Thou art!"

When I sing those verses and contemplate the meaning of the words, it never ceases to amaze me that God came to us as a humble baby—born in a messy cattle stall so that He could save a messy and broken world from sin and death. As the holy Scriptures prophesied hundreds of years before Christ's miraculous birth: "He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely, He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed (Isaiah 53:1-5)."

Because we are healed through His forgiveness and faith, we have His amazing gift of eternal life. During Advent, we worship Him and reflect about His coming kingdom that shall have no end. According to God the Father's perfect timing, God the Son, Jesus Christ, will return to the world He created, and He will restore a new heaven and new earth just as promised in His word: "And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them, and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away." And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." And He said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true." Then He said to me, "It is done. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end (Revelation 21:3-6)."

Because of these promises, we come to celebrate what Christ has done. We also come with an attitude of hope that Jesus our Savior and Lord will indeed restore a new and eternal earthly and heavenly kingdom!


