Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus.

He called out to them, "Friends, haven't you any fish?" "No," they answered. He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.

Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water. The other disciples followed in the boat, towing the net full of fish, for they were not far from shore, about a hundred yards. When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread.

Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish you have just caught (John 21:4-10).

Dear Peace Lutheran Family, I have great news for you! "He is risen!" Jesus died on the cross for our sins, and He rose again from the dead. Hallelujah! So, what's next? As Jesus told His weary disciples, it's time to "bring some of the fish," and add it to what He's already provided. In other words, when we come together and worship Him, when we have fellowship, when we pray together, when we receive the sacrament together, etc. we bring "our catch" to what He's already given to us—being changed by His eternal forgiveness and faith.

We don't come together because we "have to". Rather, we come together because Jesus invites us to "bring our catch" to what He's already given to us—to bless one another with His presence, grow in His forgiveness and faith to spread His love (i.e. "His catch") to our neighbors in physical and spiritual need. No doubt this past year has been challenging—physically and spiritually. Because of Covid, everyone has had to adjust, ensuring everyone's safety.

While we want to continue to ensure people's safety, we want to encourage you to return to worship "in house" if it all possible. Though our wonderful livestreaming is a great tool to minister to people, the effort of coming together physically to serve Christ and our neighbor, brings "our catch" to His table. By bringing our catch to Him we let go of our fears, doubts, troubles, etc.

It is easy for me to feel afraid and want to stay back like the disciples did at first in the boat, probably feeling overwhelmed with shame that they deserted their Savior at Calvary. However, Jesus never shamed them; He never shames us. Rather, in His grace and forgiveness, He provides "the catch" for us, and He calls us to bring what He has given us to Him—to His fire—to His table—so that we are filled with His redemptive presence to worship Him and to tell our neighbors about Him.

We are so grateful for the love and giftedness that Christ has given each one of you, and the more we come together, the more we grow in His eternal presence of sharing with others what He has already given to us.

Thank God for each of you, and we hope you and your families have a blessed Holy Week and Easter.


