Outdoors.... Weather Permitting The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in right paths for his name 's sake. Psalm 23:1-3

Dear Family at PLC,

Grace to you and peace from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

The verses I quoted from the recognizable Psalm of David – the one-time shepherd, war hero, servant and eventually successor of King Saul, leader of God's People, musician, worship leader and a beloved friend. Though he had many imperfections which Scriptures are not shy about recording, David's trust in his Lord as a shepherd who would guide him, provide for him, care for him, and watch over him, is a model for us all.

Last October Dianne and I went on a retreat with other pastors on the shores of Lake Okoboji in Northern Iowa with LCMC Pastors who were considering retirement from their pastoral roles. We were led in a meditation of Psalm 23. The Lord used that beautiful familiar Psalm to remind me of my life thus far. I saw God's hand in the major decisions I (we) had made. I realized how loving generous and kind God has been to me and how he has taken such good care of me – though I, like David, wasn't always cooperative!

I took stock of how God has led me and how his leading has kept me from want. Again, not that I didn't complain about his provisions or want something more, but I discovered that God has led me and provided me with countless "green pastures" and "still waters".

God led me out of a 3-decade career in Campus Ministry to be the Pastor of Peace Lutheran Church. I had said that I would never become a pastor of a church because I knew too many of them who didn't seem very happy in their job or with those they served.

Being selected to fill the position of your retiring Pastor Bill Duffey while I was still recovering in a hospital bed, was a tremendous vote of confidence that our "Shepherd-God" was leading me, and I should follow.

I can honestly say that it has been a "blessed journey" to be your pastor. It has been an honor and privilege to serve in this role. I never would have imagined what the Lord had in store for me! I am filled with love and thanksgiving for the staff and members of this church family. Those who have served alongside me as council and committee members, encouragers, counselors, and good friends, have been God's tools to support and care for me. Many, many thanks!

Without a doubt, my service as your pastor has enriched me, stretched me, and humbled me. Little did I know what a wonderful place God led me. When my retirement begins on June 1st, I cannot tell you what will happen next or where I (we) will go. Only that I say with confidence that *"surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long."*

Help Needed in the Peace Gardens


