# FAMILY MINISTRY TEAM CHECKLIST

This checklist will help you prepare and carry out your Ministry for Sunday Service. You will serve as GREETERS & USHERS. It is best to have at least <u>two</u>, or more to be Greeters/Ushers. The responsibilities for Greeters and Ushers are divided according to need and desire. The items below on the checklist seem to be "numerous" but they are important to serving this ministry. Whether you are new or "seasoned" at this ministry, please READ and CHECK these guides before time to serve. **Some changes have been made and will be revised as time-goes-by.** 

### **Before Worship:**

- 1. If you are a Greeter/Usher please arrive at the church 30 minutes before the service begins.
- 2. Open the 2 doors in the Sanctuary. Turn thermostat temperature up to 67 during the winter.
- 3. Be sure to pin on your name button right away! The buttons are on the bulletin board in the outer foyer, or with the bulletins in the Altar Guild kitchen.
- 4. Bulletins are found in the Altar Guild kitchen.
- 5. Peace Lutheran coffee mugs are to be given to visitors. If you are not sure, ask them if they had been 'mugged' yet. Giving the mugs can be done as they come in or better yet, as they come out and the Pastor is greeting them.
- 6. At about 15-20 minutes before the service, stand near the front door by the narthex table to welcome all who come to worship. You will shake hands if this is comfortable for you and hand out bulletins. It is important for you to make visitors feel welcome (talk with them) and introduce them to others, especially Pastor. This welcome to visitors is extremely important!
- 7. Use the counter to keep track of number in attendance. At the end record this number on the attendance record in the altar guild kitchen (right inside above the light switch). These numbers are important, so please be as accurate as possible. If children are handling the counter (which they like to do), it might be a good idea to have an adult also keeping track as a back-up.
- 8. Please don't close both sanctuary doors. Close the one closest to the stairwell, but leave the other one open (per council & pastor preferences).

### **During Worship:**

- 1.Sit near the entrance in pews or folding chairs so that you can assist latecomers with the bulletins, and finding a place to sit.
- 2. During communion by tables, starting with the first rows, usher the congregation to the front; while one group is being served, direct the next group to line up at the front of the center aisle. (If there are no musicians in the front, around 10 to 12 people from each side. If there are musicians, 6 to 8 is good). If communion is continuous, be sure to usher the congregation so that there is a good flow and order as they come to the front.

### After Worship

Pick up bulletins and other papers left on the pews.

Make sure that all visitors are made welcome in the Fellowship Hall and Sanctuary. Introduce them to other members and invite them to come back!

### **REFRESHMENT TEAM INSTRUCTIONS**

Refreshments are brought, set up, and served by all families on the Team. Contact your fellow team members to arrange duties and refreshments.

- Please try to be at the church by 9:30 a.m. to set up and start the coffee in the Fellowship Hall. Coffee instructions are on the refrigerator. If possible set out 'treats', juice, water, plates, napkins, silverware (if needed), etc. for the fellowship time after worship, so that they are ready.
- Leave the service a few minutes early to get to Fellowship Hall to serve for coffee time. Set out any treats that need to be.
- Clean up the serving area. This includes the counter, empty coffee urn, (excess coffee can be put in carafes) fill dish washer and turn it on if it's full, empty garbage cans, reline with bags, and put garbage in the dumpster cans outside the back door. Sweep tile floor as needed; use carpet sweeper if necessary.
- After you put your garbage in the dumpster, please roll the dumpster(s) out to the alley. Our garbage pick-up is early Monday morning. Ask someone to help you if necessary.
