## The Pastor's Page.....

Dear Peace Lutheran Family,

As we prepare for the fall season (my favorite!!) I'm reminded of Jesus' words in John 15:4, "Remain in Me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the Vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in Me."

That word, "remain," or "abide," is essential. Jesus Christ--being fully God and fully man--comes to us in ordinary means. In other words, He comes to us in simple, tangible things that we use daily. Regarding Jesus' message in John 15, ordinary things like vines, vineyards, grapes, and wine were and still are used all the time. While I'm certainly no expert when it comes to planting and harvesting grapes, I have learned that the fruit "remaining," or "abiding," in the vine is the strongest part of the crop. The nutrients the grapes receive are at their best when they are connected to the VINE!

Likewise with faith, Jesus used this "common means" or "ordinary vehicle" (i.e., the vine) to explain that, in His divine grace and faith, He is "The Vine," and we are "The branches," where we receive His everlasting gift of forgiveness and faith, which produces Christ-centered, everlasting spiritual fruit--just as Scripture explains in Galatians 5:22-23, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control."

Without being connected to the Father's "Living Vine," it's impossible to have His everlasting, spiritual fruit living in us, but through Jesus Christ, God's Living Vine, His Holy Spirit always produces spiritual fruit through us that abides forever. So, when we come to the Lord's table to receive His holy supper, we are receiving the Living Vine's true body (the bread) and His true blood (the wine) for the forgiveness of our sins and for the hope we have in producing His spiritual fruit that lasts.

With that in mind, we (leaders on church council and I) are eager to serve you the Lord's Supper to remind you that our "lifeline" is always connected to God's Living Vine, Jesus Christ, and to thank you for being a faithful part of this body of believers who receive His everlasting gift of forgiveness and faith and who desire to be spiritually-fruitful--just like Jesus.

God bless you, and thank you for all that you do.

SUNDAY SCHOOL AND ALL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION CLASSES ARE UP AND RUNNING!


Thanks to our dedicated group of teachers!
