We entered the season of Advent! "Advent" in Latin means "Coming" or "Arrival". During this incredible season, we remember the significance of Jesus' first "coming" to save us from sin and death, just as He promised, "I have come to give life and to give it abundantly (John 10:10)." Through Jesus' sacrifice on the cross for our sins and His glorious resurrection from the dead, we have his abundant gift of faith and life in Him, but there's more.

We not only gather to remember Jesus' first coming where He willingly died for us and rose again from the dead. We also remember that, through His sacrificial death and resurrection, we look forward (we anticipate) His "future coming". In other words, Jesus said, "In my Father's house are many rooms. I go there to prepare a place for you so that where I am there you maybe also (John 14:1-3)."



Specifically, we will focus on the following statements: Wednesday, December 1st "I am the Light of the World"; Wednesday, December 8th "I am the Good Shepherd"; and Wednesday, December 15th "I am the Door". These amazing statements that Jesus made are always fitting, especially when we, like sheep, need our Shepherd to lead us. During our worship services on Sunday mornings, we will be journeying through the gospel of Luke where we will concentrate on the life of Jesus and how His life prepares us in our "waiting" for Him and His future kingdom.

Then, this year, on Christmas Eve, we invite you to our Christmas Eve services. The first service is at the Sorensen Clinic on December 24th at 5:30 pm. The second service is at Peace Lutheran Church with Holy Communion at 8:00 pm.
