Dear Peace Lutheran Family,

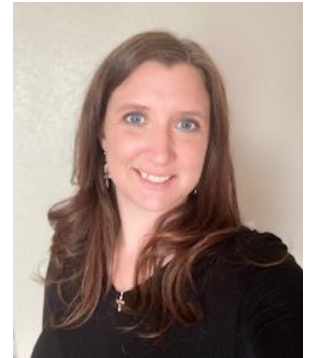

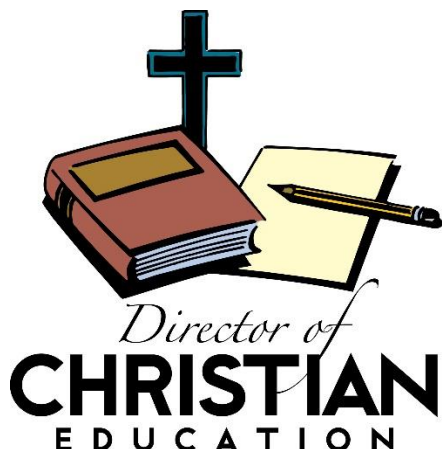
