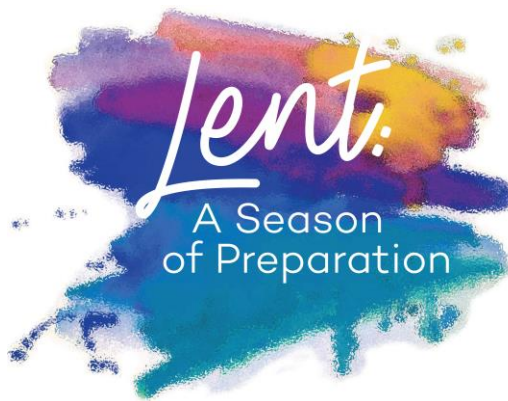

cross.**



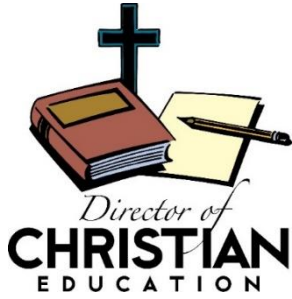

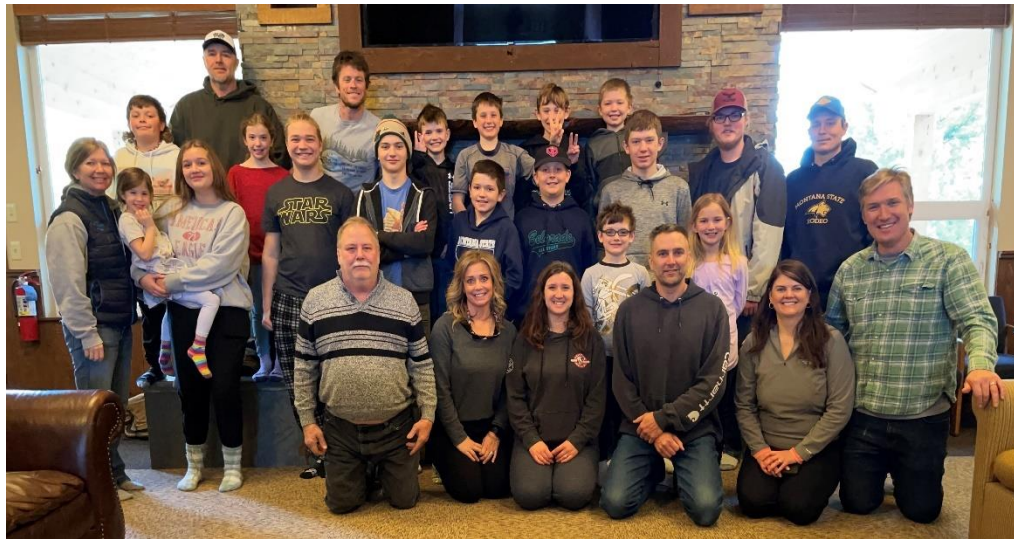
