



Valentine's Day is a typical holiday that reminds us of love shared between spouses, but the greatest love that anyone could ever have is the steadfast love of Jesus. St Paul explained it very well in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8, "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.
