#### Dear Peace Family,

Thank you for spending time with us this Lenten season! I have thoroughly enjoyed learning more about Jesus' parable of the prodigal son with you and your families. Next Wednesday, April 6th, will be our last midweek Lenten worship gathering. To quickly review, we have looked at this story from the perspective of the youngest son and the eldest son, but what about the prodigal father? Is there such a thing? Looking forward to having you join us next Wednesday for that as Pr. Bill Young will preach this parable from the father's perspective.

Then, on Sunday, April 10th (Palm Sunday) we will march into Holy Week. With that in mind I should ask, when you think of a processional, what images come to mind? People waving something in their hands and shouting the names of the special guests, right? Imagine Jesus though. Sure, the Jews are waving palm branches and shouting, "Hosanna!" "Hosanna!" "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord (Matthew 21:9)." The title, "Hosanna!" refers to "the One" who saves. No doubt, Jesus is the Hosanna who saves! No doubt, He--the King of kings and Lord of lords--deserves our highest praise! However, He didn't come into His holy city in the way that they/we would have expected. He didn't come riding into Jerusalem on a mighty stallion, wearing bright shiny armor. No, He came riding in on a lowly donkey, but why?

The prophet Isaiah who ministered to Jesus' ancestors several hundred years before His miraculous birth summed it up well about "the reality" of Jesus' "processional" into Jerusalem. From Isaiah 53 the prophet preached, "He had no stately form or majesty that might catch our attention, no special appearance that we should want to follow him. He was despised and rejected by people, one who experienced pain and was acquainted with illness; people hid their faces from him; he was despised, and we considered him insignificant. But he lifted up our illnesses, he carried our pain; even though we thought he was being punished, attacked by God, and afflicted for something he had done. He was wounded because of our rebellious deeds, crushed because of our sins; he endured punishment that made us well; because of His wounds we have been healed."

Fast-forward to Jesus' entrance into His holy city. Not long after hearing the celebratory praises from the Jews, "Hosanna! Hosanna!" Jesus would hear, "Crucify Him!" Crucify Him!" from the same people. Amazingly, Jesus knew this and continued to follow through with the most humble, loving sacrifice in history--giving His innocent life for sinners "enemies of God because of sin" so that, just as Isaiah preached "Because of His wounds," on the cross for our sins we could be healed.

Knowing this, it'll amaze you the next time you read about Jesus riding into His holy city on a lowly donkey.


