Dear Peace Family,

The grace and faith of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ be with you all.

As we prepare for this coming Lenten season, I'm reminded of one of the most thought-provoking stories that Jesus ever told. [A couple things to keep in mind as Jesus told this story.] First, Jesus was dining with "sinners", and the "holier than thou" religious leaders thumbed their noses at him. They couldn't believe he would dine with such "spiritually unclean" people. Second, when Jesus told this amazing story, he was traveling to Jerusalem to fulfill what Scripture said about the Lord being the, "*Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world* (John 1:29)."

In response to the religious leaders' arrogant attitudes towards Jesus and those who were "spiritually unclean" Dr. Luke records the story that Jesus told about a father's forgiveness for not one but two "lost" sons. Starting with the youngest son (a.k.a., "the rebel") the father says to the eldest son (a.k.a., "the perfectionist") "*My son, the father said, 'you are always with me, and everything I have is yours. But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found* (Luke 15:31-32)."

The Dutch artist Rembrandt captured this amazing story in an incredible painting with the youngest son looking ragged and falling into the merciful arms of his father. Meanwhile, standing closely behind, the oldest brother has a look of disgust and bitterness on his face. He can't believe that his father would show such unmerited favor towards his little brother who was wasteful with his father's wealth. With that background, it seems fitting to ask, how would you respond as the father in this story? What about the eldest son? How about the youngest?


Again, I want to repeat what Jesus said to the religious leaders that accomplishes what the eldest and youngest sons needed the most: "*My son, the father said, 'you are always with me, and everything I have is yours. But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found* (Luke 15:31-32)."

Everything that King Jesus has--everything that he accomplished for you and me on the cross is ours through Him. His resurrection that guarantees new and abundant life in his heavenly kingdom dwells with us--now and forever. But here's the important thing. If we want to live the new and abundant life that we have in Christ, we need to start by coming humbly and honestly to the merciful and faithful arms of our Heavenly Father like the youngest son did.

Folks, that's what the season of Lent is all about. It reminds us that though we don't deserve the Heavenly Father's abundant wealth (His everlasting kingdom of love, faith, truth, etc.,) He came to us through King Jesus to seek and to save the lost, and whether you are a "rebel" or a "perfectionist" the "need" is still the same--God's unmerited favor for you and me.

God bless you this Lenten season.
