Greetings Peace Lutheran Family!

The leaves are changing, the weather is changing, the hours of daylight are changing...the fall happens to be my favorite time of year! Despite the changes, we have hope in the One who never changes. Jesus Christ--the Alpha and the Omega--the Beginning and the End--is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

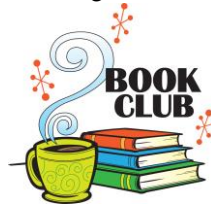

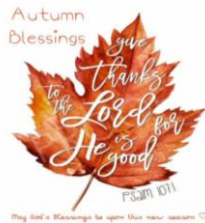
