I hope you had a wonderful Memorial Day Weekend. Looking ahead into the season of Pentecost, we are going to take a trip through the Old Testament. Specifically, we are going to look at the Spirit-filled lives prophets Elijah, Elisha, Daniel, and Jonah. We will begin with Elijah and Elisha. *I will provide a short outline for the summer months, starting in June. See the schedule with Scripture passages and sermon titles. Thank you! *Pr. Andrew*

- 2nd Sunday in Pentecost -- Sunday, June 11th, 2023: Scripture Lesson: 1 Kings 17:1-6
 - Sermon Title: "The LORD Provides for Elijah"
 - *Bible Reflection Verses: Psalm 23:5-6, "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. 6 Surely your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever."
- 3rd Sunday in Pentecost -- Sunday, June 18th, 2023: Scripture lesson: 1 Kings 17:7-14
 - Sermon Title: "A Little in the LORD's Hands Goes a Long Way"
 - *Bible Reflection Verses: Matthew 17:20-21, "Because you have so little faith, truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."
- 4th Sunday in Pentecost -- Sunday, June 25th, 2023: Scripture lesson: 1 Kings 17:15-24
 - Sermon Title: "Look, your son is alive!"
 - *Bible Reflection Verses: John 11:25-26, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"
- 5th Sunday in Pentecost -- Sunday, July 2nd, 2023: Scripture lesson: 1 Kings 18:16-40
 - Sermon Title: "The Bonfire!"
 - *Bible Reflection Verses: 1 Kings 18:37, "Answer me, LORD, answer me, so these people will know that you, LORD, are God, and that you are turning their hearts back again."


