- New Members Sunday On Sunday, November 19th, towards the beginning of the worship service, we will recognize new members at Peace Lutheran Church.
- *New Youth/Children's Worship Participation/Fellowship Opportunity -Starting on Sunday, January 7th at 9:00 am, we are going to start a new "worship/fellowship" opportunity where we have youth/children involved in the worship service.
