Thank you for joining us for this spiritually-meaningful season of Lent. As we "Let go and Let God" lead us, I hope and pray that your journey with Jesus and each other is uplifting. Moving forward, we will continue to learn about the ways that God's people in the Old and New Testament "Let go and Let God" lead them, praying and trusting in His calling. What did Moses learn? 
