"Christ is risen!" Hallelujah for the empty tomb! Thank God for His Son's eternal gift of amazing grace and faith--where not even death could keep Him! Let Jesus' empty tomb encourage you in your faith journey with Him and each other.

I want to thank all of the musicians, the choir, and the pastoral staff for serving diligently during this memorable Lenten season and Holy Week! And "Thank you!" Peace Lutheran family for being committed in sharing Jesus' love with others. Thank you for your friendship. Thank you for your prayers. Thank you for your generosity.

Moving forward, we have the joy of learning/applying the steadfast hope and faith of Jesus' resurrection. How did Thomas overcome his fears and doubts?

What about Cleopas and the other disciple, walking on the road to Emmaus, feeling confused and doubting everything they believed about Christ?

What about the women--the "Marys," Salome, Joanna, etc? They came to Jesus' tomb, bringing with them aromatic spices that they had bought. They were expecting to see a corpse. They wanted to pay their respects, but instead, they saw the stone rolled away and that Jesus was raised from the dead, just as the Lord's holy messengers declared to them, "*Why do you look for the living among the dead? Christ is not here; He has risen* (Luke 24:5)."

Jesus' living faith is God's gracious gift to us. Jesus removes our *stones/burdens* and provides His saving faith to trust in Him. Jesus showing "*doubting Thomas*" His imperishable scars on his hands and side to remove the "*terrified, unbelieving scars*" in Thomas' heart.

Knowing that they would be terrified/amazed beyond belief--Jesus met the "Mary's", Joanna, Salome, etc. and commissioned them to tell the other apostles about His eternal resurrection. "*Christ is risen*!" Isn't that our calling too?

Jesus--crucified, buried, and raised from the dead--always meets us where we are and gives us His gift of steadfast faith to worship and serve Him. What story has God given to you to share about Jesus' resurrection?
