Greetings Peace Lutheran Family,

Wow! It seems like the summer flew by! Our kids and grandkids are back in school. As we prepare for this fall, I wanted to draw your attention to the autumn sermon series: "Mile Markers of Faith". Imagine going on a hike. When you reach each mile marker on your journey, what's new about the scenery around you? What's different?

When you reach your destination, what have you learned about your journey?

In this series, we will be going on a journey into exploring God's gift of faith in our lives. While we will still read the Old Testament passage, Responsive Reading, and Gospel text each Sunday--I want to draw your attention to the Epistle Readings for this particular topic as they relate to God's gift of faith in Christ's living body--the church.

*Please see the dates and themes below:

- Sunday, September 1st, 2024 -- *Faith Prepares* (Ephesians 6:1-10)
- Sunday, September 8th, 2024 -- Faith Confronts Adversity (James 1:1-8)
- Sunday, September 15th, 2024 -- Faith Reveals Integrity (James 2:1-13)
- Sunday, September 22nd, 2024 -- Faith Speaks Wholesome Words and Actions (James 3:1-10)
- Sunday, September 29th, 2024 -- *Faith Yields to Jesus--Daily!* (James 4:1-10)

At the conclusion of each sermon, I will post on our church website three discussion questions, a "Bible memory verse", and a "Prayer of the week" that focuses on an aspect of God's faith in your life. Feel free to use this exercise to strengthen your personal walk with Jesus. Use it after family supper times or when you go to work. However, you choose to use it--let it encourage your personal, faithful relationship with Christ and others.

I'm very excited about teaching Confirmation and 1st Communion classes again. We have several teens and kids involved in both classes. Confirmation students will be going over the Old Testament this fall. They will begin on Sunday, September 8th. We will begin the semester with God's creation and being made in His image. The first class for the First Communion students will be on Wednesday, October 9th.

Lastly, the "Digging Deeper" Bible study on Tuesday afternoons will start again on Tuesday, September 10th from 1:00-2:30 pm.

LOVE, INC (In the Name of Christ) is a multi-faceted ministry, uniting 54 Christian churches around the Gallatin Valley who come together to act as the hands and feet of Christ in our community — Peace Lutheran is one of those partner churches. Love, INC's ministry includes clothing, personal care products, furniture, linens, transportation to medical appointments, car repairs, trauma recovery classes, and life skills classes. Rather than being a "handout" organization, they offer a "hand up" to people in need by sharing Christ with clients, providing for their current needs, and helping them with tools and resources to move from surviving to thriving. LOVE, INC serves as the call center, taking requests and then coordinating with volunteers from area churches who serve in specific ways. Anyone interested can certainly find a way to utilize their individual gifts to help others in the name of Christ. PLC has a group that sorts clothing donations once/month, we have folks who provide rides, others who do mechanic work at the car clinic, etc. For more info, chat with a volunteer, or go to loveincgc.org.
