Mission Moment - Operation Christmas Child (OCC)

The mission of Operation Christmas Child (part of Samaritan's Purse) is to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to children in need around the world. The boxes are filled with toys, school supplies, and hygiene items, and since 1993 over 220 million children in more than 170 countries have received an OCC shoebox. For many of these children, it is their first gift ever. Local Christians distribute the gifts during outreach events, telling the children about God's Greatest Gift, Jesus Christ. Many of these children then participate in a 12-lesson discipleship program, which includes Bible stories and Scripture memorization as they learn how to follow Christ in their daily lives and tell their family and friends about Him.

Peace Lutheran has been involved the past 3 years, packing 45 boxes in 2022, 49 boxes in 2023 and 48 boxes this year. We can also track which countries the boxes are sent to. The past two years our boxes have gone to Mexico, Benin, and to some "hard-to-reach" places where the Gospel is restricted. We look forward to finding out where our boxes go this year. Thank you to all of you who have helped with this wonderful program.


