

We are turning the corner into the summer season! It's time to get outside and enjoy the Lord's marvelous creation. Hit that hiking or biking trail. Toss in a line and try to catch that beautiful Cutthroat. Have dinner out back on your patio. Try something new and share what you're learning with a new friend. The opportunities are endless.

Speaking of something new, we are going to engage in an exciting new sermon series starting in June. (*The scripture lessons in the Old and New Testament correspond with the 2025 Sola Lectionary.) The series forms an acrostic "PRAYS" – Prepare (June 1st) Receive (Pentecost Sunday June 8th) Affirm (Holy Trinity June 15th) Yield (June 22nd) and Sacrifice (June 29th). Each sermon theme applies to the relevant Scripture passage in the Sola Lectionary. The hope of this sermon series is to encourage new, applicable lessons in your life that honors your relationship with Christ and passes the true hope of the gospel to someone else. Looking forward to the applicable lessons that the Lord puts in your heart!

In July we are excited for a new Vacation Bible School titled, "Live It Out—Discover How to Love Like Jesus." Like exploring the outdoors by camping, we are going to explore the depth of Jesus' unending love for us and in sharing His love to others. Thinking of this theme, I'm reminded of the apostle John's first letter when he wrote, "This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and gave His only son as the atonement for our sins (1 John 4:10)." There are plenty of ways that you can help us spread the message of Christ's atoning love. Please let us know how you would like to be involved in Vacation Bible School.

Finally, we hope to utilize our new Personal Care Pantry ministry in partnership with Love Inc and other churches to share the hope of Jesus in our valley. Besides Peace Lutheran as the host church for this ministry, the other churches included are Seventh Day Adventists (Belgrade), Light of Christ Fellowship (Independent Lutheran church in Bozeman—Four Corners area), and Belgrade United Reformed Church. I'm excited that we can partner with our brothers and sisters in Christ and share His hope with people in physical and spiritual need.

Vacation Bible School


VBS is July 21st to 24th from 9am to Noon.


