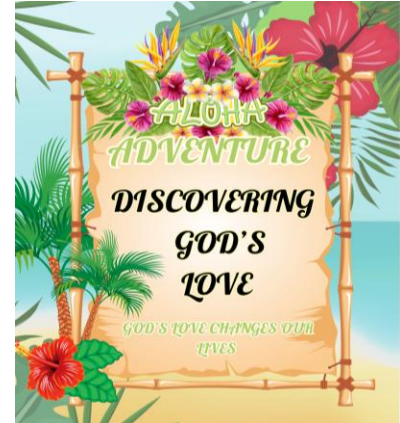


Summer Kick Off BBQ is June 14th.
